### **Mowing work in Starkey Park starts tomorrow**

To help keep woody and invasive species under control, mowing and overseeding will take place in part of Starkey Park beginning tomorrow, Nov. 30. This will take place in the prairie/wildflower area under the powerlines and continue downhill leading to the creek. Park users will still be able to access the trails and work is anticipated to be finished within one or two days.

Because of the location of the powerlines, burning is prohibited and mowing is used as a subsequent treatment method. To supplement the mowing, overseeding of prairie species will take place in the upland portion of the powerline easement. A similar overseeding was conducted two years ago on most of the lower area under the powerlines during the work needed for the bank stabilization project.
