Big-4 Rail Trail tree work taking place

Pings Tree Service is working on behalf of Zionsville Parks Department to remove approximately 35 Ash trees along the Big-4 Rail Trail, primarily between Eagle Creek and Town Hall. All the trees being removed have succumbed to the Emerald Ash Bore. Trail users should be mindful of the work that is taking place and may experience short interruptions while utilizing the Trail.

Weather permitting, the work will take nearly two weeks to complete. The Parks department has plans for additional tree removal in the near future to clean up what the Emerald Ash Bore has destroyed. This work is being done for the safety of trail users and to avoid potential damage to parks and neighboring structures.
