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Virtual open house for Zionsville-Indianapolis Executive Airport Land Use Study

The Town of Zionsville and the Hamilton County Airport Authority have announced a virtual open house to receive public input on a new Land Use Plan for properties around the Indianapolis Executive Airport. The virtual open house will take place on Thursday, November 19 at 6 p.m. via Zoom (<https://us02web.zoom.us/j/87480277273>). No in-person option to attend the event will be available.

The purpose of the open house is to gather public input on draft concepts from a team of consultants related to future land use and development around the airport.
