Zionsville kicks off comprehensive plan process

The Town of Zionsville has posted a [Comprehensive Plan Request for Qualifications \(RFQ\)](#) – the first step of the process to develop a new Comprehensive Plan. The new plan will include goals, policies, objectives and implementation strategies related to various aspects of future growth including land use, transportation, utilities and economic development.

The Town's current Comprehensive Plan was adopted in 2003. Mayor John Stehr believes developing a strong Comprehensive Plan is one of the most important actions a municipal government can take.

"Since our last Comprehensive Plan was adopted, Zionsville has changed dramatically and the population has nearly tripled," Stehr said. "A new Comprehensive Plan is the blueprint for our way forward. It will build on the town that we love, helping us guide growth in a way that complements and enhances Zionsville. It will be our roadmap for the next generation."

RFQs must be submitted by February 16, 2024 and the consultant will be selected on March 16, 2024. The project is anticipated to require 12-18 months for completion. Throughout 2024, there will be broad-reaching opportunities for the community to provide input, and those will be announced on the [Town's website](#).
