# USING A CART IS BENEFICIAL BECAUSE...

Convenience: Trash and recycling carts are easy to move and transport, making it convenient to dispose of your waste and recycling materials.

Improved sanitation: Carts help keep trash and recycling contained, reducing litter and improving sanitation in neighborhoods.

Reduced litter: With a lid that keeps waste and recycling materials secure, carts help reduce litter caused by wind-blown debris.

Cost-effective: Carts are more cost-effective than traditional garbage bags or bins, as they can be used for years without needing replacement.

Increased recycling rates: Recycling carts make it easier for residents to recycle, which can lead to increased recycling rates in communities.

Improved safety: Carts are designed to be safe and easy to use, with features such as sturdy wheels and ergonomic handles that reduce the risk of injury.

Reduced odors: Carts help contain odors from waste and recycling materials, reducing unpleasant smells in neighborhoods.

# HOW TO USE YOUR CARTS AT THE CURB

- 1. Place at the curb with the lid opening facing toward the street
- 2. Lids must be closed to provide service
- 3. Place carts at least 3 feet away from each other



4. The automated collection process will put the cart back in close proximity to where the cart originated. Carts should not be placed close to vehicles, mailboxes, and landscape decorations.



# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

"I have a trash cart already, can I just continue to use that cart?" - A new trash cart will be delivered to your home. This cart should be the primary cart used every week and your other cart can be used as a secondary cart as needed

**"Can I use any trash cart as a secondary trash cart?" -** YES! Priority will collect all materials contained in a trash cart. You are able to use up to two trash carts each week. If you would like to have two of the same carts, you can purchase another Priority trash cart at www.prioritywaste.com/waste-recycle-bin-order-form/ and select Zionsville, IN in the drop down menu.

"I only need one trash cart and do not have space for a second one. What should I do with my old one?" - Priority will collect and dispose of old carts that you do not need. Simply place the cart at the curb with a note taped to the cart or a RED "X" so we know it is okay to throw away.

"When can I throw away the old cart that I no longer need?" - Priority is asking residents to dispose of their old trash carts on their OFF WEEK FOR RECYCLING to avoid overloading our crews. For example, your house is an A Week recycle residence. You can throw away the old cart you no longer need on the B Week recycle collection schedule.

- ✓ Recycling Collection will remain on an Every-Other-Week schedule, on the next page is a schedule for you to follow. Each section is divided into A & B recycling weeks.
- ✓ Clean plastic bottles & Containers #1, 2, 4, 5, &7
- Clean food & beverage cans or cartons
- ✓ Paper
- Clean flattened cardboard & paperboard
- Clear and colored glass bottles
- ✓ Each house is allowed up to two recycle carts to be collected on the every-other-week schedule.
- ✓ For more information on acceptable materials, go to www.prioritywaste.com/cities-we-serve/ zionsville/
- ✓ Priority will continue to service the current recycling carts. Over the next few months, Priority will affix a sticker with our logo and contact information. Should you need a repair or replacement, contact Priority at 855-WASTE-65 (855-927-8365).





- ✓ Your service day may have changed, make sure to check the service map page for the map showing which day Priority will collect your trash and recycle material.
- ✓ This new collection schedule begins April 10th.
- ✓ We start collection at 7am until we are fin-ished. The time you are serviced is subject to change week to week and we recommend placing your materials to the curb the night before your collection day.
- ✓ Now that you have received your solid waste cart, material must be contained in the trash cart to be collected, nothing can be placed outside of the cart. Should you need another cart, one can be purchased directly from Priority at our website www.PriorityWaste.com or you can call us at 855-WASTE-65 (855-927-8365).
- Each household is allowed up to two trash carts to be collected weekly.
- ✓ Bulk Item collection is not included in the traditional solid waste service. Bulk Item collection must be scheduled 48 hours prior to service.








# TOWN OF ZIONSVILLE SERVICE MAP


